Please note that your actual living expenses, including room and board, may differ depending on your choice of living arrangements. The George Washington University Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) estimates a standard amount when determining living expenses, including housing and utilities, for a graduate student living off-campus. The OSFA estimates the average out-of-pocket costs that students may incur, such as personal and living expenses; please note that these costs are variable and can be considerably less, depending on living arrangements. Program students recently surveyed indicated average expenses lower than those included above.

**Books & Supplies

The George Washington University Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) estimates books and supplies based on credit hours (\$100 per credit up to 15 credits). Please note that the average cost for books and supplies beyond the first semester tends to be less than those published.
